- Face coverings – either cloth or disposable masks – are required for all children over the age of 2 while inside the museum.
- Disposable masks are available upon request and free of charge.
- Enhanced cleaning protocols are in place and additional hand sanitizing stations have been installed throughout the museum.
- Plexi-glass barrier has been installed at the entrance desk.
- Visitors will receive styluses to use with the NEW Touchscreen exhibits to eliminate the amount of contact required.
- Visitors are asked to maintain physical distance from other groups and wait until smaller spaces are clear before entering.
